

The Discovery Center at Water's Edge will be a major regional science, technology, and heritage center located along the Route 40 corridor in Belcamp, Maryland. It will be a place where students of all ages and abilities explore, experience, invent, create, and play with science and technology.



At full scale, the Center will attract over 100,000 visitors each year, contribute millions into the local economy, and be an active STEM resource for our local residents. Our vision is to inspire and excite the next generation of innovators through scientific discovery and technological heritage.



We'll do this in three ways:

1. Provide a facility specifically designed for people to engage in science inquiry and exploration with hands-on exhibits and activities to stimulate critical, creative, and computational thinking
2. Deliver programs for science learning in the schools and in the community through events, competitions, classroom visits, mentoring, and other science-rich experiences.
3. Create and disseminate science media in the form of virtual exhibits and multimedia experiences.
